Autumn 1

Drawing

- Third dimension means making an object look solid by using drawing techniques.
- Perspective is to make a drawing appear 3D on a 2D plain. E.g. A road appearing to curve in the distance or an apple sitting on a table.

Spring 1

Painting

- Tone is how light or dark a colour is.
- Shade is a darker version of a colour.
- Complimentary colours sit opposite each other on the colour wheel.

Summer 1

Sculpture

- If you 'impress' clay you make a mark in the clay by pressing or stamping an object into it.
- Carving means to use tools to scrape away parts of the clay.
- 'Coiling' means to spiral the clay in an upward motion to form a shape.
