The Doot Doot Song	 Duration is the length of time each note is played for. Beat is the heartbeat of the music. Pitch is how high or low a sound is. Melody is an arrangement of notes. A chord is 2 or more notes played at the same time and work in harmony. Structure is the way a piece of music is organised. Timbre is the quality of a sound. Improvise means to make up the music on the spot.

Spain	 Duration is the length of time each note is played for. Rhythm is a pattern of long and short sounds. Pitch is how high or low a sound is. Melody is an arrangement of notes. Dynamics is the volume of music Habenera is a dance style of music with a specific rhythm, often associated with Spain.
Summer 1 and 2	
Monsters, Monsters Instrumental Unit: Recorder	 Duration is the length of time each note is played for. Time signatures show how many beats are in each bar. Crochet – a note worth one beat. Quaver – a note worth half a beat. Semiquaver – a note worth half the duration of a quaver (a quarter of a beat). Minim – a note worth two beats. Dotted notes – add half of the note's worth eg. a dotted minim would be worth 3 beats (minim = 2, add half of 2 = 1 therefore 2+1=3). Semibreve = a note worth four beats. A rest is a pause in the music. Pitch is how high or low a sound is. Melody is an arrangement of notes. Structure is the way a piece of music is organised. Timbre is the quality of a sound.
