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 Fine journey water takes as tennoves from the faile to the sky and back again is called The Water Cycle. Evaporation is when water changes from liquid to gas due to heat. Condensation is when water vapour cools and turns into clouds. Precipitation is rain, hail, sleet and snow that fall from the clouds. Collection occurs when water that falls from the clouds, collects in oceans, rivers, lakes and streams. Most will infiltrate (soak) into the ground and will collect as underground water. The draining away of water from the surface of the land back into a river / lake / ocean is called run-off.
