Name and locate Coasts and Rivers in UK

- Rivers are split into 3 sections: the upper, middle and lower course.
- The source is where a river begins, usually on higher ground.
- The mouth of the river is the point where the river joins the sea.
- The largest river in the UK is the River Severn which flows through parts of Wales and England.
- A coast is where the land and sea meet.
- A beach is a strip of land by the sea or ocean.
- A cliff is a steep rock face usually at the edge of the sea.

The Water Cycle

- The journey water takes as it moves from the land to the sky and back again is called The Water Cycle.
- Evaporation is when a liquid (for example, water) changes to a gas due to it being heated.
- Condensation is when water vapour (gas) is cooled down, which then it changes into a liquid (for example water).
- Precipitation is rain, hail, sleet and snow that fall from the clouds.
- Collection occurs when water that falls from the clouds, collects in oceans, rivers, lakes and streams. Most will infiltrate (soak) into the ground and will collect as underground water.
- The draining away of water from the surface of the land back into a river / lake / ocean is called run-off.
