<b>Mechanisms</b> Sliders and Leavers	<ul> <li>Mechanisms – An item that creates movement.</li> <li>A slider moves backwards and forwards through a slit.</li> <li>A slider can move from side to side or up and down.</li> <li>A lever is fixed at one point and moves from side to side in an arch.</li> <li>By attaching a picture to the end of the slider or lever you can make the picture move.</li> </ul>

Structures Freestanding structures	<ul> <li>A frame is a structure that surrounds something such as a picture, door, or windowpane.</li> <li>Straws can be joined to make a frame.</li> <li>Straws can be joined by using pipe cleaners.</li> <li>The frame can be made stronger by gluing triangles in the corners of the straws.</li> </ul>

<b>Food</b> Preparing fruit and vegetables	<ul> <li>Fruit and vegetables can be eaten without cooking them.</li> <li>Some fruit and vegetables need to be peeled before we eat them – peeling is when the outside layer (skin) is removed.</li> <li>Some fruits have hard stones in the centre – these can't be eaten.</li> <li>Some fruits have small seeds or pips – these can be eaten but we don't usually eat them.</li> </ul>
