- Un, deux, trois, quatre, cinq, six, sept, huit, neuf, dix, Onze, douze, treize, quatorze, quinze, seize, dix-sept, dix-huit, dix-neuf, vingt

- (French months do not have capital letters) janvier, février, mars, avril, mai, juin, juillet, août, septembre, octobre, novembre, décembre
