A reptile is an animal that has scales, lays eggs on land and is cold-blooded. A carnivore is an animal who only eats meat. A herbivore is an animal that only eats plants. An omnivore is an animal that eats both meat and plants.

Plants	 A plant has roots and grows in the ground. Roots are part of the plant that attaches it to the ground. Plants have leaves, stems or trunks and roots. Some have flowers or seeds. Deciduous trees lose its leaves in the Autumn and stays bare until Spring. An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in Winter.
